Most questions are graded on the following rubric:

- 0 = does not possess needed communicative/problem solving skills
- 1 = shows some of needed communicative/problem solving skills
- 2 = possesses average needed communicative/problem solving skills
- 3 = demonstrates above average communicative/problem solving skills

1. What is your name and grade level you are in?
 - Look for good eye contact and confident in speaking
2. Do you ride the bus?
 - just a simple yes or no answer

 - a) A friend comes up to you and takes some money out of your hand and runs off with it. What do you do in this situation?
 - grade on quick responsiveness
 - also grade on quality of course of action taken in situation
 - b) You are at a friend's house sleeping over and your friend brings out a PG-13 movie. You know that your parents don't want you watching PG-13 movies. What do you do?
 - c) You start to leave home to go to a friend's house and your Mom reminds you to wear your helmet when riding. When you meet up with your friends, they want to continue riding but no one is wearing a helmet. What do you do?
 - d) You're at Walgreens with a friend who takes some candy off the shelf and puts it in his pocket. He then says "let's go" and walks toward the store exit. What do you do?
4. Have you ever helped somebody solve a problem? What was the situation and what did you do?
 - grade on quick responsiveness
 - also grade on quality of course of action taken in situation
